STAR 360 Reading Results Update



205 (65%) of our students improved 50 or more points (names will be posted in the hallway) while 75 (23%) of remaining students improved from 1 to 49 points.

Seven (7) students improved by 300+pts: Semaj Bellamy (397 pts.); Myles Youmans (333 pts); Robert Young (318 pts); Laron Dobson (305 pts); Liberty Francis (300 pts)- All Kindergarteners, Da'Nea Heyward - 4th grade, and James Moore (396 pts.)- 5th grade.
